## **Position Summary:**

The **Manager of Regional Health Collaboration** is responsible to support and serve as the point of contact for healthcare collaboration initiatives with Horizon, Department of Health, MedavieNB as well as other provincial stakeholders in the Western NB region. The role focuses on strategic community engagement, workforce development, and collaboration with regional healthcare facilities to improve sustainability services and growth of the healthcare workforce.

## Key Responsibilities:

- Liaison with health authorities to the region, including physicians, nurses, pharmacists, and other allied health professionals.
- Collaborate with educational institutions, professional organizations, and recruitment staff from the Department of Health and Horizon to build a talent pipeline.
- Act as a resource for current healthcare professionals to address challenges related to workforce retention, workplace culture, and operational concerns.
- Facilitate communication between healthcare providers and community stakeholders to resolve issues impacting healthcare delivery.
- Provide support to navigate regulatory and administrative challenges that affect healthcare practices.
- Build strong relationships with community leaders, local government agencies, and regional organizations to enhance community support for healthcare initiatives.
- Advocate for policies and programs that support healthcare workforce sustainability and professional growth.
- Act as the point of contact for the provincial recruitment team to facilitate and coordinate candidate visits to the region.
- Other assigned projects and activities as directed by the CEO

- Minimum of 5 years of experience in healthcare recruitment, workforce development, community relations, economic development, communications, or a related field.
- Strong understanding of healthcare workforce challenges, especially in rural communities.

- Ability to work collaboratively with diverse stakeholders, including healthcare providers, community leaders, and educational institutions.
- Willingness to travel within the region as needed.
